



Limited, Non-Transferable, Warranty

Advantage 25, an exterior coating, is warranted for 25 years under a Limited Non-Transferable Warranty. The product, when applied according to its specifications, will not crack, peel, flake, blister, or chalk (Warranted Defects) from the day of application. The Advantage 25 Warranty is only applicable to light and/or pastel colors. Colors using the accent or deep bases are not covered under this warranty. Areas around leaking downspouts or gutters that drain improperly, areas of damaged wood or other substrate, areas previously alligatored, areas around or in regular contact with leaking, shall not be covered under this Warranty. This Warranty will not cover vandalism, defects in or failure or damage to the exterior wall or foundation of the building, any structural defects, or any other cause not involving inherent manufacturing defects in the product, Advantage 25.

This warranty covers only the product, Advantage 25, against the failures indicated herein and does not include the application of the product. The painting contractor/applicator, under a separate agreement with the property owner(s) needs to ensure that the application has been done in accordance with the Specification or Technical Data Sheet. Should the coating fail due to its application, this warranty shall not apply. Further, should the product fail, under "normal environmental conditions" and without being tampered with, neglected, abused, and/or covered in any way with any other coatings and/or paint products, only the product covering that portion that has been proven to have failed through no fault of the application, will be replaced. Under no circumstance shall any project in its entirety be corrected unless it can be proven that the product has failed over the entire project. In addition, extreme weather conditions, hurricanes, tornadoes, earth quakes, fire, terrorism, or any act of God, are also not covered under this product warranty.

Any failures of Advantage 25 must be reported in writing within 30 days of said failure to be qualified under the Warranty for replacement. A copy of this executed Warranty must accompany any written declaration of said product failure. EverLasting Coatings & Paints (aka ECP,LLC) reserves the right to personally examine and/or test and remove any material associated with a claim of product failure to ensure the validity of said claim. ECP, LLC also reserves the right to enlist the assistance of experts in the field of chemistry and coatings and paints prior to validating any claim under this Warranty. This written Warranty is in lieu of any other warranties either oral or otherwise.

The laws of the United States of America and the State of Maryland shall govern this warranty. In the event of a civil suit, it shall be filed and litigated in Montgomery County, Maryland.
